SCHOOL FEES:

"After consultation with Fr. Shabin the per child Curriculum Levy and Excursion/Incursion Levies have remained the same as 2016 however the per family School Fee has increased by \$50 to \$1450.00

Please be aware the Curriculum Levy (\$220 per child) and the Excursion/Incursion Levy (\$60.00 per child) are DUE & PAYABLE by 17th March.

The School Fees (\$1450 per family) can be paid in full initially, or in three instalments of roughly a third. First Instalment: due End of Term One (Friday 31st March). Second Instalment: due End of Term Two (Friday 30th June). Third & Final Instalment: due End of Term Three (Friday 22nd September).

Therefore ALL MONIES are DUE & PAYABLE by Friday 22nd September (End of Term Three) including all additional year based costs such as: Sacraments, Camps etc.

School Fee Statements will be sent home soon, together with comprehensive details of our payment options which include Direct Debit.

We appreciate your co-operation in meeting these deadlines. Please contact the School Office if you have any difficulties with any of the above and mutually agreeable arrangements can be put in place.

IMPORTANT: Beginning of the year Parent / Teacher 5 minute "Getting to Know You interviews will be held between 3.15 – 5.30 pm. next Monday 6th February.

The purpose of this meeting is to learn as much as we can about your child from you. It is NOT a progress report but rather a sharing of information meeting.

We ask ALL parents to attend. If you are unable to make this meeting we ask you to arrange with your child's teacher another mutual date and time to meet in the near future.


PARENTS & FRIENDS FIRST MEETING:
