Wednesday 31st January was the 90th Anniversary of the Opening of our school. The original school shared the Catholic hall (located on the west corner of Rayner Street and Railway Street North) that also served as church, dancehall, meeting place and cinema. In a letter to the Cathedral written that day, Fr. Flannery, Parish Priest, stated that he had counted 50 children in attendance. Four months later the Inspector of Schools reported an enrolment of 86 pupils graded from Infants to Grade 8.

The first nuns to teach in Altona were Sister Damien (Principal) and Sister Leon who arrived by train from the Newport convent each day wearing the brown habit of Australia's Sisters of St. Joseph.

In 1950 a new St. Mary's church-school, built at a cost of 25,000 pounds (\$50,000) opened on our current site in Railway Street.

We had a school photo taken this week involving all children and staff forming the number 90 on the netball court to celebrate the occasion.

There is an enormous amount of information in this newsletter so please take your time to read all of it. It may also be worthwhile to keep it somewhere that you can refer back to it.

It was fantastic to see so many parents, grandparents, friends and past students on the netball court for the beginning of the school year, including our Parish Priest, Fr. Shabin. There seemed more excitement and anxiousness on some of the parents faces than the children's. Thank you to the many parents, both new and existing, who joined us for a cuppa afterwards. It was great to catch up. Thank you to Merilyn Fischer & Susie Holland and their helpers for their organisation of the morning tea and scrumptious food.

Moving around all of the classrooms it is amazing how quickly the children settle into their new classrooms. The staff and I are looking forward to working with you in partnership to make 2018 a very enjoyable and successful year.

A Special welcome to our forty-eight Prep children and their families.

SCHOOL FEES:

Curriculum Levy will remain the same for 2018. However the Family Fee and Excursion fee have increased:

Family Fee (per family) - \$1500.00 Curriculum Levy (per child) - \$220.00 Excursion Levy (per child) - \$70.00

Additional charges for Camps, Sacraments etc will be added to your school fees dependant on the year level of your child/ren.

Please note in a change from past years, one third of your total school fee is to be paid by the end of Term 1 (29/03/2018), two thirds of the total fee by the end of Term 2 (29/06/2018) and the final third paid by the end of Term 3 (21/09/2018). Failure to do so will result in your account being placed in arrears.

School Fee Statements will be sent home next week, together with comprehensive details of our payment options which include Direct Debit.

Beginning of the year Parent / Teacher 5 minute "Getting to Know You" interviews will be held between 3.20 – 5.30 pm on Monday 5th February.

The purpose of this meeting is to learn as much as we can about your child from you. It is NOT a progress report but rather a sharing of information meeting.

We ask ALL parents to attend. If you are unable to make this meeting we ask you to arrange with your child's teacher another mutual date and time to meet in the near future.

WEEK TWO: LITERACY ASSESSMENT WEEK

In 2017, all staff were involved in looking at a new reading assessment tool called the Benchmark Assessment System otherwise known as the BAS.

The BAS is a tool that identifies not only a child's reading level but also his/her ability to **comprehend** what they have read. The information gained from this assessment will be used to identify strengths and weaknesses in the students which teachers will be able to address when planning lessons.

Therefore in Week 2, all students from Year 1 to Year 6 will be assessed using the BAS. This requires teachers to work one on one with each student for 40 minutes. To enable this to happen, all classroom teachers will be given 3 days to complete this testing with a part of a fourth day available if necessary.

Staff who do not have a classroom such as support staff and the specialist teachers etc. will be working in classrooms but we have also employed a number of Emergency Teachers to assist with this process. As a result there will be no Performing Arts, Creative Arts or Physical Education sessions next week.

Implementing the BAS has required a lot of time, money and organisation but we feel the benefits will far outweigh the costs.
