Integrated Studies

Innovative Inventions and Inventors

Our term topic is based on the broad concept of 'CHANGE.' Students will investigate inventors and inventions. They will explore the inventions that have changed the way people live and how technological advances have affected different aspects of our lives.

Physical Education

In Physical Education this term, students will be participating in a track and field athletics program. They will participate in an Athletics trial day where they have the opportunity to be selected for our school's district athletics team. A continued focus will be developing students understanding of health and fitness, where they will participate in a cardio test (beep test). They will also develop skills and knowledge of the following sports; Athletics, Touch Rugby, and Lacrosse.

Art

In Art this term students will be working on creating a claymation film clip. They will be working in a partnership to write a script, draw a storyboard, create a set, make plasticine characters and then film and edit their work. This also ties in with our visit to AMCI in late August to attend the Wallace & Grommit exhibition.

Performing Arts

In Performing Arts this term, we will be learning through the art of Drama. Students will be exploring the use of their voices and developing characters and scripts to create puppet plays. Students will also be learning songs to participate in our community events. We will end our term with an Open Stage Day — an opportunity for all students to perform for their classmates. A wonderful way for all students to develop confidence!

Social and Emotional Learning

This term the students will focus on developing a 'Growth Mindset'. This will encompass the ability to show resilience when faced with challenges, encourage mistakes to help understanding and thinking positively during difficult tasks.
