SCHOOL FEES:

After consultation with the School Education Board the School Fees for 2016 are as follows:

School Fees (per family) -	\$	1400.00
Curriculum Levy (per child) -	\$	220.00
Excursion/Incursion Levy (per child)	• \$	60.00

The per family School Fee has increased from last year due in part to a reduction in government funding as a result of our social – economic rating increasing. The Curriculum Levy and Excursion/Incursion Levy have remained the same.

Please be aware the Curriculum Levy (\$220 per child) and the Excursion/Incursion Levy (\$60.00 per child) are DUE & PAYABLE by Friday 18th March.

The School Fees (\$1400 per family) can be paid in full, or over a number of instalments but is **DUE & PAYABLE** by Friday 9th September (2nd last week of Term Three). School Fee Statements will be sent home soon, together with comprehensive details of our payment options. We appreciate your co-operation in meeting these deadlines. Please contact the School Office if you have any difficulties with any of the above and mutually agreeable arrangements can be put in place.

IMPORTANT:

Beginning of the year Parent / Teacher 5 minute "Getting to Know You interviews will be held between 3.15 - 5.30 pm. next Monday 1st February.

The purpose of this meeting is to learn as much as we can about your child from you. It is NOT a progress report but rather a sharing of information meeting.

We ask ALL parents to attend. If you are unable to make this meeting we ask you to arrange with your child's teacher another mutual date and time to meet in the near future.

Below are some questions you may wish to talk with your child's teacher about:

How does your child socialise with other children? What does your child enjoy about school? What special needs your child has eg. medical etc. Is there any extra information which you think we should know about your child to make their year enjoyable?

There will also be a Local Excursion School Permission Form and Photograph/Video Permission Form for you to read and sign outside each classroom.

If your child has the same teacher as last year and circumstances haven't changed you do not have to make an appointment.

Fees for Guitar Lessons, 2016

Term 1 – 6 lessons - \$138 Term 2 – 7 lessons - \$161 Term 3 – 9 lessons - \$207 Term 4 – 10 lessons - \$230

The Term fees need to be paid **within the first three weeks** of each term, otherwise your child will not be able to continue with guitar lessons. An Invoice will be provided at the start of lessons each term with information regarding method of payment.

To remind you also that if there are lessons lost through illness, timetable changes or short holiday period with none of these extending beyond two timetabled lessons, these lessons will be made up in the last week of each term. If any holidays are planned during a school term, I need to be notified in advance in writing.
