## **COMMENCEMENT OF SCHOOL 2016:**

The Staff will commence on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> January. <u>ALL CHILDREN INCLUDING PREPS</u> commence at <u>8.50 am on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> January.</u> Children assemble with their bags on the netball court. We will have a short assembly. Year One – Six then move to their classrooms with their teachers. Once all other levels have moved out of the area our preps will then

follow their teachers to their classrooms. The Parents and Friends on behalf of the school invite all parents to the hall for a cuppa and a chat and some scrumptious food.
