

The number of people permitted in the church is up to **75 people.** Density quotient **1 person per 4 sqm applies.** 

It will only be necessary to ring in and book your name If you wish to attend the 10.30am Mass on Sunday. Please ring the parish mobile: (0434 088 900) and book by 3 p.m. the previous day. Parishioners are required to QR their entry which means you will need to bring your mobile phone from now on, or sign in your full name and phone number only if you do not have a smart phone.

Masks must be worn indoors and the 1.5 metres physical distancing rule applies.




