

What best summarises the theme of today's readings is perhaps Paul Tillich's concept of 'ultimate concern'—that object of a person's fundamental commitment and devotion. The readings invite us to reflect deeply on what matters to us in life, what gives purpose and shape to our existence, and what claims our unconditional allegiance. They warn us against placing our hope in finite realities that cannot ultimately satisfy us; the 'false gods' that lead to disillusionment and despair, instead of the true and living God who gives life to the world.
