

This year, the Play's management is offering free bus transport to and from the Play for the Palm Sunday performance only (2nd of April at 1.30 p.m.). The bus will leave from Mary Help of Christians Presbytery (97 Railway St. Nth) at 11.45 a.m. sharp and will make its way to Queen of Peace, Altona Meadows and then continue on to Templestowe.

If you wish to catch the bus from Altona, please place your money in an envelope, marked 'Passion Play" with your full name, phone number and the number of people attending and place your envelope in the presbytery letterbox which is located on the lefthand side of the front security door.
