

Feast Day of Mary, Help of Christians 24th May, 2021

Background to the Feast: The Feast of Mary, Help of Christians, which is celebrated on 24 May, has been celebrated in Australia since 1844. However, the history of this day dates back to an earlier time in Europe (16th Century), when it was not at all peaceful. Catholics across that continent joined in praying the rosary in the hope of saving their homelands from war. Their prayers were answered and the feast day was declared. The prayers we now pray as we say the rosary are special reflections on Mary's life. The Catholic Church, when beginning in Australia, had a special reason for turning to Mary. In those early days of the NSW colony, there were no Catholic priests. So, it was largely the rosary that kept the Catholic faith alive. Catholic Australians remained faithful to Mary, and Australia was the first nation to choose her, under the title of Help of Christians, as Principal Patron Saint. We turn to Mary today and ask her for prayers, and we ask her to help all those in any kind of need. We ask her to bless, and guide, all who live and work within our Altona suburb:




