Finding Christ in a COVID Christmas - being offered by the Proclaim: Office for Mission Renewal.

Beginning on Thursday 20th October 2020 and offered over four weeks, these Advent formation sessions are looking to bring the season to life in their local communities in this time of uncertainty with COVID restrictions. # Children's Week Activity: "Just as I have loved you"




