Once again Insight SRC is conducting a survey on behalf of the Catholic Education Office, Melbourne and our school. Sixty randomly selected parents will receive an envelope containing instructions and the survey next week. You can choose to complete it online or a paper copy.

The online version is open from Monday 29th August until Friday 16th September; the paper version needs to be returned to the school office, sealed in the supplied envelope, also by Friday 16th September as they need to be returned to Insight SRC. Any surveys returned after this date cannot be included. Participation in this survey, while strongly encouraged, is completely voluntary.

If you receive a survey and you do not wish to participate please return it immediately to school and we can offer it to another family. If you haven't received a survey and you would like to complete one we have a few spare copies so please contact the school office and we will send you one.

All staff and our Year 5/6 students will also complete a survey prior to the 16th September.

We are seeking the support of our parents as we believe our parent voice is important to help shape the ongoing improvement of our school. The main aim of the survey is to identify factors that contribute to the organisational health of your child's/children's school and provide valuable information about what is going well, and not so well, and the ways in which this may be improved and built upon. We are consulting families to gather your input to shape the future development of our school. Please remember your individual responses will remain confidential and can only be accessed by Insight SRC. Feedback will be provided to us, based on the collective answers of all parents who participate in this survey. Thank you in advance for your participation.


