As mentioned in last week's newsletter, next year we will be introducing the online application CareMonkey. As a parent/guardian you will receive an invitation to join CaremMonkey and enter details for your child/children. By following the instructions you can create your own free CareMonkey account and control all data about your child/children. The CareMonkey system stores the information on your behalf and you will be able to grant (or deny) access to your data with our school. You are able to share this data with any other groups or individuals you choose (eg. your child's grandparents, their child-minder, their sports club, even your child's secondary school etc).

You can use a PC, laptop, tablet or smartphone to enter the details including:

- emergency contacts
- medical contacts
- medical checklist including asthma, allergies, seizures, diabetes
- health and ambulance insurance details
- notes and other care instructions from you
- and more . . .

From the school's perspective, this information will only be visible by the relevant staff for your child and will be managed in accordance with the Privacy Act.

You don't need to do anything until you receive the email requesting the information. However, it is important to note that as of 2017 we will no longer be using paper forms to collect information from you (especially signatures for excursions and camps) so you will need to ensure that you follow the instructions in the email before the new school year begins. 
