Dear Parents

Attached to this newsletter is Draft Two of a Building Masterplan for our school and parish. Fr Michael has asked that these plans be widely circulated and he welcomes any feedback. The first drawing is an overall plan of the entire site including the church, presbytery, school buildings and grounds as well as the property (owned by the parish) behind our Year 3/4 building.

On the last school day of last year we received an invitation from the Catholic Education Melbourne Grants Committee to submit an application (to be completed by the end of January) on behalf of the school. The second and third drawings are what we submitted. If we are successful in progressing to the next stage of the process we will initiate an extensive consultation process with staff and parents and any changes can be made as long as we don't change the focus. That focus being 12 General Learning Areas (GLA). We can't decide to build a multi-purpose hall.


Walkinga
