NEW IN 2017:

In 2017 we are going to be introducing an online application (app) called CareMonkey. CareMonkey is a health and safety solution that automatically keeps medical and emergency details up to date. It makes these important details instantly available to teachers on mobile devices in an emergency . . . so they know who to call, what to do, or what to tell an ambulance paramedic. CareMonkey automates the permission and consent form process too, which means no more permission notes sent home. Alerts will go straight to your phone and an email will notify you of forms that need to be read and signed and it's as simple as an electronic signature. Next week we will provide you with more information about CareMonkey and you will receive an email with instructions to create a CareMonkey profile so we will be ready to go for the 2017 school year.


UNIFORM SHOP 2017
